

Learning by playing, a project included in the Anna Lindh Foundation Virtual Marathon, launches the game "Holargos" and a contest to play, learn and educate yourself with it from today until June 25, play at www.learningbyplaying.es and get one of the 4 prizes that are up for grabs.

Participation will be made in accordance with the following bases:

1- The Friends of Europe Association, within the "Learning By Playing" project included in the Anna Lindh Foundation Virtual Marathon, announces the "Holargos" educational contest, taking place between June 11 and 25, 2021.

2- As many people as they want may participate in it without limitation of age, nationality or occupation.

3- To participate, you must access the educational game "Holargos" hosted on the website www.learningbyplaying.es and proceed to register.

4- "Holargos" is made up of 4 missions that will have to be completed in their entirety to be eligible for one of the existing prizes. The missions will be published according to the following calendar:

June 11 - June 15 - June 18 and June 21.

The missions can be resolved until June 25 and in the event that there is more than one score per participant, the highest score obtained will be taken.

5- Four prizes are established that will be awarded to the 4 highest scores registered on June 25, without more than one prize per person being able to accumulate.

In the event of a tie, the date on which the scores were recorded will be used as the tiebreaker, prevailing the date that had occurred previously.

For the case in which the tie remains, a draw will be made between the tied ones.

The prizes will consist of four vouchers of 50 euros, each one of them, which will be exchangeable in the next educational initiatives that will be launched from Friends of Europe, without any case being able to demand a change of the same, the cash payment of the value of the voucher or their transfer to third parties.

The organization reserves the right to declare any award as void.

6- The winners will be notified at the awards ceremony and evaluation that will take place electronically on June 28, 2021, and must be present at the event to receive their award.

7- The organization reserves the right to modify the dates indicated in the bases, publicly notifying the changes in the event that they occur.

8- The organization may disqualify any participant in the event that there are suspicions of fraudulent behavior or conduct that incurs actions against the values of the Friends of Europe Association and the Virtual Marathon of the Anna Lindh Foundation.

For what purpose do we process your personal data? We process your data to manage the “Leargning by playing” training program within the Friends of Europe Association and to maintain contact with you. As well as their transfer to the Anna Lindh Foundation, the entity responsible for the Marathon of Virtual Activities for Intercultural Education. Your data will be kept for the time necessary to fulfill the purpose for which they were collected and to determine the possible responsibilities that may arise from said purpose and from the processing of the data and until the eventual responsibilities derived from the management are prescribed. No automated individual decisions will be made or profiling will be created. Information regarding Friends of Europe activities with a marked training profile may also be sent.

What are your rights when you provide us with your data?

Interested persons have the right to obtain confirmation about whether we are treating personal data that concerns them, or not. Interested persons have the right to access their personal data, as well as to request the rectification of inaccurate data or, where appropriate,

request its deletion when, among other reasons, the data is no longer necessary for the purposes for which it was collected. Interested persons have the right to revoke or withdraw the consent granted for the processing of their data for specific purposes at any time. In certain circumstances and for reasons related to your situation.

In particular, interested persons may oppose the processing of their data or part of them, in which case we will stop processing the data, except for the fulfillment of any legal obligation. In certain circumstances, interested persons may request the limitation of the processing of their data, in which case we will only keep them for the exercise or defense of claims and for the fulfillment of any legal obligation. In certain circumstances (when the treatment is carried out by automated means and this is based on the consent of the interested persons), the interested persons may request the portability of their data so that these are transmitted to another person in charge. In certain circumstances (when the basis of legitimacy is the execution of a contract or the consent of the interested party) the interested persons may request their right not to be the subject of a decision based solely on automated processing, including profiling, that produces legal effects or affects me significantly in a similar way.
